

A major influence on the day-to-day work have the spheres of activities. These spheres describe how the region can and should be positively influenced in the upcoming years. They also have a direct impact on the projects, as projects can only be benefited via the LEADER and INTERREG program if they contribute to the local development policy.

The spheres are:

1. Competence region for alpine habitat - nature and responsibility

Sustainability combines our mountain farming culture with the modern knowledge society. East Tyrol is developing as a model in linking traditional experience with modern scientific knowledge and processes.

2. Recreation and active space for an increasingly urban society

East Tyrol - space for all senses in a pulsating and demanding world. The grandiose landscape gives the feeling of freedom and stimulates creativity. In its diversity, the source of vitality and breeding ground is a new awareness.

3. Development space of talents - appreciation, cohesion and individuality

Osttirol is aware of the value of its talented young people. We promote talent individually and offer space for the best possible development. This creates a qualitative variety of competencies as the basis for the development of an own profile. Community as a special value is emphasized and the people of the region are, in their uniqueness, the co-creators of our future!

4. Economic area with tradition - cooperation, innovation and value

Local and interregional cooperation accelerate the exchange of experience and knowledge in the shortest possible way. This creates innovation and competitiveness, supported by dedicated people.

5. Open space for people and cultures - networking and interregionality

6. IWB - (Investment in Growth and Employment which is a special funding programme) raising added value in our region

7. CLLD Dolomiti Live cross-border networking
